

The use of masks is now obligatory in all public spaces, open or enclosed, in the Region of Murcia, "whether or not there is a safety distance".

The president Fernando López Miras has announced the measure adopted in the Government Council "faced with a worrying situation and a growing risk to health". He underlined the importance of "putting a brake on irresponsible behaviour and unnecessary crowds without safety measures", and remarked that "it is up to all of us to avoid having to continue to resort to decisions that nobody likes".

The president of the Community, Fernando López Miras, has announced that, "from today, after publication in the Official Bulletin of the Region of Murcia, the use of masks will be obligatory in any open or enclosed public space, whether or not there is a safety distance". Exceptions will be considered such as the practice of sport, beaches and pools, as well as the consumption of food and drinks in bars and restaurants.
